Today's Readings:

First Reading - Responding to the revelation of God's glory accorded to him, Moses requests God to accompany his people, forgive their sins, and take them as an inheritance

Psalm - According to Daniel, these words of prayer were placed in the mouths of the three Jews who were condemned to death in a fiery furnace. Instead of dying, they walked in the furnace unscathed and blessed God.

Today's Readings

First Reading - Moses tells the people that it was the Lord who led them in the wilderness for forty years in order to test them and know what was in their heart

Psalm - This psalm has been well called "the joy-song of creation." Israel, having received a signal manifestation of the Divine power calls on all things in heaven and earth to praise the Lord.

Psalm Response -

O praise the Lord, Jerusalem

Second Reading - While speaking about Christians associating themselves with heathen worship which cannot go along with Christian worship, Paul brings in the theme of the Eucharist. The Eucharist is a sharing in the body and blood of

Gospel - The repeated Jewish objection that Jesus cannot give them his flesh to eat is countered by restating the necessity of eating his flesh and drinking his blood as the condition for having eternal life

10.30 Mass- Choir Offertory Motet - Panis Angelicus (Cesar Franck)
