### Week beginning 25th June, Twelfth Sunday of Year A

Today's Readings:

<u>First Reading</u> - (Jeremiah 20: 10-13) Through these verses Jeremiah gives vent to the bitter feelings of rejection that he experiences. The final verse of this passage expresses Jeremiah's confidence that God can change the course of events and punish his enemies

<u>Psalm</u> - (Psalm 68) In singing this psalm we must have an eye to the sufferings of Christ and the glory that followed, not forgetting the sufferings of Christians too, and the glory that shall follow them.

Psalm Response -

In your great love, answer me, O God.

Second Reading - (Romans 5: 12-15) In these verses Paul speaks about the genesis of sin. In fact, the idea of the "Original Sin" builds on what Paul teaches in this paragraph.

Gospel - (Matthew 10: 26-33) Jesus tells his disciples that they are to fear God alone and not human beings. Further, they need to trust in God's care for them

### Fr. John Writes -

This coming Thursday is the feast of Saints Peter and Paul, and is a Holy Day of Obligation, (meaning that we are obliged to attend Mass). Our Catholic Church is founded on Jesus Christ, but these two saints were the great human heroes who led the way in establishing Christ's Church in the face of every conceivable obstacle and at the cost of their own lives. We pray for our world-wide church today facing many very different obstacles - like Peter and Paul we recognise that Christ promised that He is with us on every step of the way.

The collection on Thursday is for "Peter's Pence", an ancient tradition by which all parishes throughout the world contribute annually towards not only the costs of the Holy See, but also to the Holy Father's works of mercy and charity wherever the need is greatest.
