# Newsletter for the week commencing 20th/21<sup>st</sup> April 2019 EASTER SUNDAY ( C )

**First Reading: Acts of the Apostles 10: 34, 37-43. In** this speech Peter presents in a nutshell the story of Jesus beginning in Galilee with his baptism and ending in Jerusalem with his death and resurrection. His speech ends with a call to believe in Jesus.

Psalm 118 Response: This day was made by the Lord; we rejoice and are glad.

**Second Reading: The Letter of St Paul to the Colossians 3: 1-4.** Paul tells the Colossians that they have been raised with Christ and so they must set their minds on heavenly things and not on earthly things.

**Gospel: John 20: 1-9.** Mary Magdalene goes to the tomb very early on Easter Sunday and finds the tomb empty. She reports to Simon Peter and the beloved disciple who both come to the tomb and find the linen clothes and napkin.
