First Reading: Jeremiah 17: 5-8 Jeremiah does a contrast between the person who depends on human strength for his well-being and the person who trusts in God for the same purpose. The former receives a curse while the latter receives a blessing.

Psalm: 1 and 39

Response: Happy the man who has placed his trust in the Lord

Second Reading: First letter of St Paul to the Corinthians 15: 12, 16-20 Paul responds to those in Corinth who spread the rumour that there is no resurrection from the dead. Paul argues strongly for the resurrection of the dead.

Gospel: Luke 6: 17, 20-22 In this passage we have the Lucan equivalent of the Matthean Sermon on the Mount that begins with the beatitudes. Luke gives only four beatitudes but supplements them with four woes.
