Week beginning 2 July, Thirteenth Sunday of Year A

Today's Readings:

First Reading - (2 Kings 4:8-11, 14-16) The elderly woman of Shunem, whose respectful service to Elisha, the man of God, is rewarded with the promise of a son whom she lacked

<u>Psalm</u> - (Psalm 89) The lectionary selection focuses solely on the celebratory portion of this psalm and this first section praises God's steadfast love and faithfulness.

Psalm Response - I will sing forever of your love, O Lord

Second Reading - (Romans 6:3-4, 8-15) Paul writes that Jesus came in the likeness of sinful flesh and broke the dominion of sin and death by his own death and resurrection

Gospel - Matthew 10:37-42) Jesus cautions his apostles about non-hospitality and rejection but nevertheless they will be welcomed by some gladly. He adds further that even a glass of cold water given in hospitality will be rewarded

Fr. John Writes -

I am confident that there are enough young people in our parish to form a preparation group for the <u>Sacrament of Confirmation</u>. Qualifications to join this group are: to be over 12 years old and under 17 years old, to be willing to participate regularly in our preparation sessions over a period of months. I am hoping that we might have some good fun on this journey together, lots of discussion, and some good insights into our Faith on the way. In the Church porch there are some slips of paper headed CONFIRMATION - please fill one in and hand it to me. I am hoping that our meetings may be on Saturday afternoons but this depends a lot on who is coming and what other commitments they already have on weekends. But we will decide when and how often we meet (and consequently when the Confirmation ceremony will be). If we start planning now, we could be ready to start after the summer holiday period finishes.

Next Sunday is Sea Sunday when we will have the annual collection for the Apostleship of the Sea (AoS). The Aos is a Catholic charity supporting seafarers world wide providing practical and pastoral care to all mariners regardless of nationality or belief. Port chaplains and volunteer ship visitors welcome seafarers, offer welfare services, advice, practical help, care and friendship. The seafarers spend up to a year away from home, separated from their families and loved ones and often working in harsh conditions. The AoS relies wholly on voluntary contributions and can only continue its work through the generous donations of its supporters, particularly this collection.

Last year we held a party as a way of thanking all of you in the Parish who regularly give up your time to help ensure the Parish runs as smoothly as it does. Deacon Jolyon and I would like to invite you and a guest to attend a "Thank You" event **NEXT Saturday 8th July at 7.30pm** (after the 6pm mass) in the Parish Centre as our way of thanking you for the work you do. Food and drink will be provided.

Please write your name, your guest's name and the volunteer group you work with, e.g., Choir, Readers, Cleaners, Flower arrangers, Eucharistic Ministers, Children's group, Money Counters, to name but a few.
